

Gift and Travel Contribution Register

The Local Government (Rules of Conduct) Regulations 2007 requires elected members to notify the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) within 10 days of accepting a notifiable gift. A notifiable gift is a gift (or two or more gifts within six months) between \$50 and \$300 received from a person who is undertaking, seeking to undertake, or who it is reasonable to believe is intending to undertake, an activity involving Council discretion. Elected members and staff are prohibited from accepting gift/s above the value of \$300.

The Shire of Carnamah Code of Conduct requires staff to notify the CEO within 10 days of accepting a notifiable gift.

The CEO is required to maintain a register of notifiable gifts.

The below register shows all notifications received by the CEO from 1 February 2016 onwards. The Gift Register up until this date and Annual Returns will continue to be available for viewing at Council's Administration Centre.
