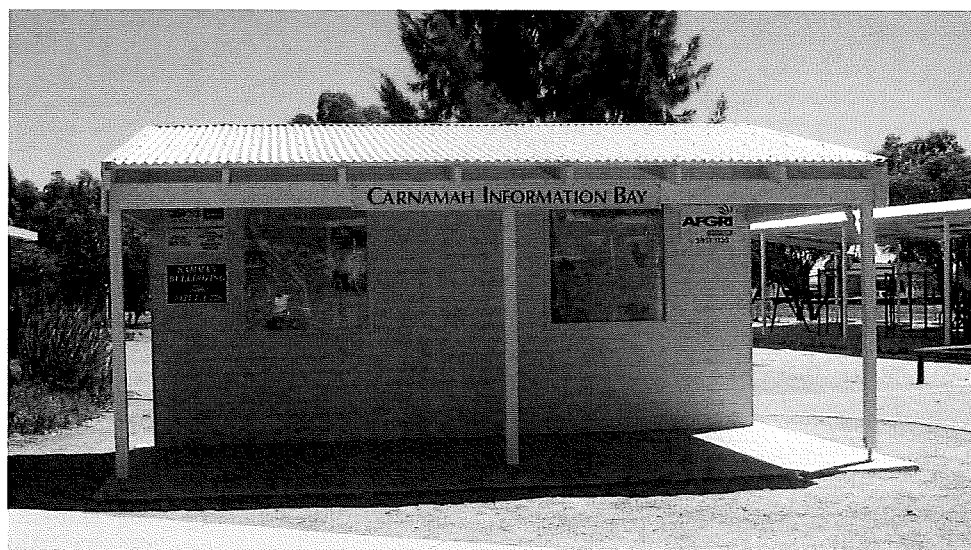


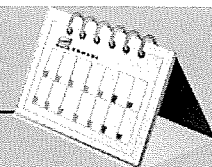

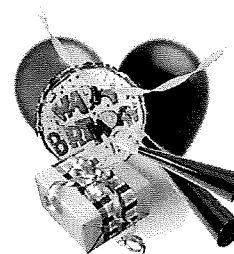

Crop Updates Debrief

A fantastic day was had by all 110 attendees of the 2014 Crop Updates held on the 5th March in Dalwallinu. The annual event is a series of presentations by scientists, agribusiness representatives and growers which aim to inform farmers in the Liebe region about the latest research and development in order to assist preparations for the upcoming season.

With herbicide resistance being a hot topic again this year, Peter Newman from the Australian Herbicide Resistance Initiative covered the good and bad news with glyphosate resistant radish. We also had Grant Thompson from Crop Circle Consulting, talk about how to manage stacked resistant radish with herbicide.

This year saw the return of the popular concurrent sessions which allows participants to choose presentations based on their interests. Joe Delaney from Elders – Scholz Rural spoke to a full room about the economics of fallow, whilst in the other room Christian Nansen from UWA spoke of using fertilizer strategies, drones and apps as new approaches to pest management.

Another popular session was David Feinburg from Lupin Foods Australia who gave an update on the process he have been involved in to get Lupins from the feed market to the food markets. Attendees were also treated to dips made from lupins during the presentation.

Michelle Cowan from the South Fremantle Football Club finished off the day with a presentation on Gen Y in the Workplace, with 75% of the workforce going to be Gen Y's by 2025, she gave tips on how to get the best out of them.

The success of the 2014 Liebe Group Crop Updates is, like all Liebe Group events, due to the continuous support and the commitment of our members and partners.

RESULTS– Carnamah Landcare Fox Shoot

Last Friday, March 7th, was the first Carnamah Landcare fox, cat and rabbit shoot. Seven teams met up at my place with an arsenal fit to start WW3 and headed off in their separate directions at around 7pm. A fox was worth 20 pts, cats (feral only) worth 10 and rabbits worth 5. The highest point scorers on the night were team "What' oh" with 395 pts, consisting of 77 rabbits and 1 cat, all done in about 2 1/2 hours. Harmon must have regained his strength after the swimming carnival. Next on points and the most foxes were "Foreign Legion", consisting of Morgs, Simon, Dermi, Finn, and Connor Brown with 315 pts. 7 foxes, 29 rabbits and 3 cats were hauled in a great all around effort; there will definitely be no lead deficiency in Richard's paddocks. Next was the Lone Ranger, Brown Dog with 80 pts, 3 foxes and 4 rabbits. The girls did better than a couple of teams with 1 fox (stuffed toy) and 1 cat (pet and still alive).

In total, there were 14 foxes, 4 cats and 110 rabbits removed from the environment and more to come with various baiting programs in action. Thanks to everyone that supported the evening.

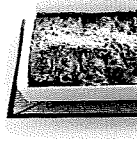
Recipe

spinach and ricotta cannelloni

- 1 quantity basic tomato sauce (see recipe, below) or 500ml ready-made tomato pasta sauce
- 4 fresh lasagne sheets, halved lengthwise
- ½ cup finely grated parmesan cheese, extra

filling

- 2 bunches English spinach, trimmed
- 750g fresh ricotta
- 1 cup finely grated parmesan cheese
- 2 tablespoons chopped flat-leaf parsley leaves
- 1 tablespoon chopped dill
- ½ cup fresh breadcrumbs
- sea salt and cracked black pepper



Preheat the oven to 180°C (350°F). To make the filling, blanch the spinach in a saucepan of boiling water for 5 seconds, then drain, squeeze out any excess moisture, and chop. Combine the spinach, ricotta, parmesan, parsley, dill, breadcrumbs, salt and pepper. Spread one-third of the tomato sauce over the base of a greased 20 cm (8 in) x 30 cm (12 in) ovenproof dish. Lay a lasagne sheet on a flat surface, spoon on some ricotta filling and roll up. Place in the baking dish, seam-side down. Repeat with the remaining filling and sheets. Pour the remaining tomato sauce over the cannelloni, sprinkle with the extra parmesan and bake for 25–30 minutes or until heated through.

Serves 4.

Basic tomato sauce short order: Heat a large saucepan over medium heat. Cook 2 teaspoons olive oil, 2 chopped garlic cloves and 1 chopped onion for 4–5 minutes or until tender. Add 2 x 400g (14 oz) tins lightly crushed tomatoes, 3 teaspoons sugar and ¼ cup chopped basil leaves. Simmer for 10 minutes or until thick and pulpy. Serve with pasta and add ingredients such as chicken, olives, tuna, anchovies or chilli as desired.

sticky pork with rice noodles

- 180g rice stick noodles
- ¼ cup honey
- 2 tablespoons soy sauce
- 2 tablespoons oyster sauce
- ½ cup (125ml) water
- ½ teaspoon chilli powder
- 1 clove garlic, crushed
- 2 x 300g pork fillets
- vegetable oil, for brushing
- 1 tablespoon vegetable oil, extra
- 1 tablespoon finely grated ginger
- 1 bunch (350g) gai larn (Chinese broccoli), blanched and halved

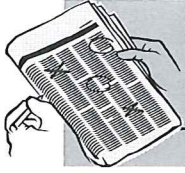

Place the noodles in a bowl and cover with boiling water for 10 minutes or until separated and tender. Drain and set aside.

Place the honey, soy, oyster sauce, water, chilli and garlic in a bowl and stir to combine. Set aside. Heat a frying pan over high heat. Brush the pork with oil and cook for 1 minute each side. Add the honey mixture, cover, reduce heat to low and simmer for 6–8 minutes or until pork is cooked through and the sauce is thickened. Remove from the heat and slice.

Heat a wok or large frying pan over medium heat. Add the oil, ginger and gai larn and cook, stirring, for 2–3 minutes or until the gai larn is tender. Divide the noodles and gai larn between plates, top with the pork and ladle over the sauce to serve. Serves 4.
