RESTRICTED & PROHIBITED BURNING

Please be advised that the prohibited and restricted burning times are as follows:

RESTRICTED (Permit Required)

- 17th September to 15th October 2013 (East of Brand Mudge Road)
- 17th September to 1st November 2013 (West of Brand Mudge Road)

PROHIBITED (NO BURNING ALLOWED)

- 15th October 2013 to 31st January 2014 (East of Brand Mudge Road)
- 1st November 2013 to 31st January 2014 (West of Brand Mudge Road)

RESTRICTED (Permit Required)

- 31st January to 15th March 2014 (All Sectors)

Burning is not permitted on Sundays or Public Holidays during the Restricted Burning Period.

Permits must be obtained during Restricted Burning times.

ACCESSING WATER FROM THE ENEABBA AND CARNAMAH TOWN STANDPIPES

The standpipes in the Eneabba and Carnamah townsites are now governed by way of electronic card access.

Those wishing to access standpipe water will need to acquire a card from the Shire Office in Carnamah. A \$50.00 deposit will be required for the card and water will be charged out on the same basis as previously.

This does not apply to the standpipe on the Carnamah-Eneabba Road.

Grassroots sporting clubs to benefit from CSRFF

Member for Moore, Shane Love MLA is encouraging local sporting organisations to apply for the latest round of Community Sporting and Recreation Facilities Fund (CSRFF) small grants.

Sport and Recreation Minister Terry Waldron last week announced \$750,000 in grants was available for projects that encouraged local communities to keep active and participate in sport.

Mr Love said many regional not-for-profit sporting and recreation clubs, community groups and local government authorities had benefitted from the \$20 million per year CSRFF program in the past.

"Through this important fund the experience of sport and recreation pursuits undertaken by members of Moore communities are enhanced," Mr Love said.

"This ultimately results in greater levels of active participation and adds to the overall wellbeing and health of individuals."

The grants are especially designed for those cases where grassroots clubs and councils need financial assistance to complete a project which might otherwise be out of reach.

Grants are for a total project cost of up to \$150,000.

Works undertaken can include floodlighting, safety fencing, change room facilities, storage and skate park upgrades.

Mr Love said sport was especially important to WA's regions, providing an enjoyable social outlet as well as binding communities through a common interest.

The 2014-15 CSRFF February Small Grants closes at 4pm on March 31, 2014.

then Wednesday 2nd April, 7th May, 4th June, 2nd July, 6th August, and 3rd September

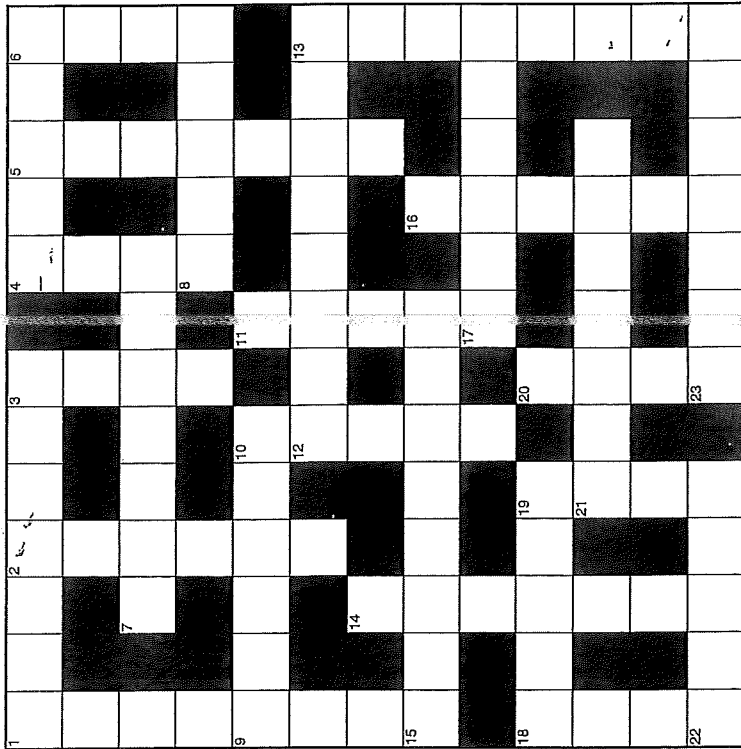
Bring your paints and other materials, join in for some inspiration or just come for a chat. We come from all backgrounds, using various media and learn and help each other when needed.

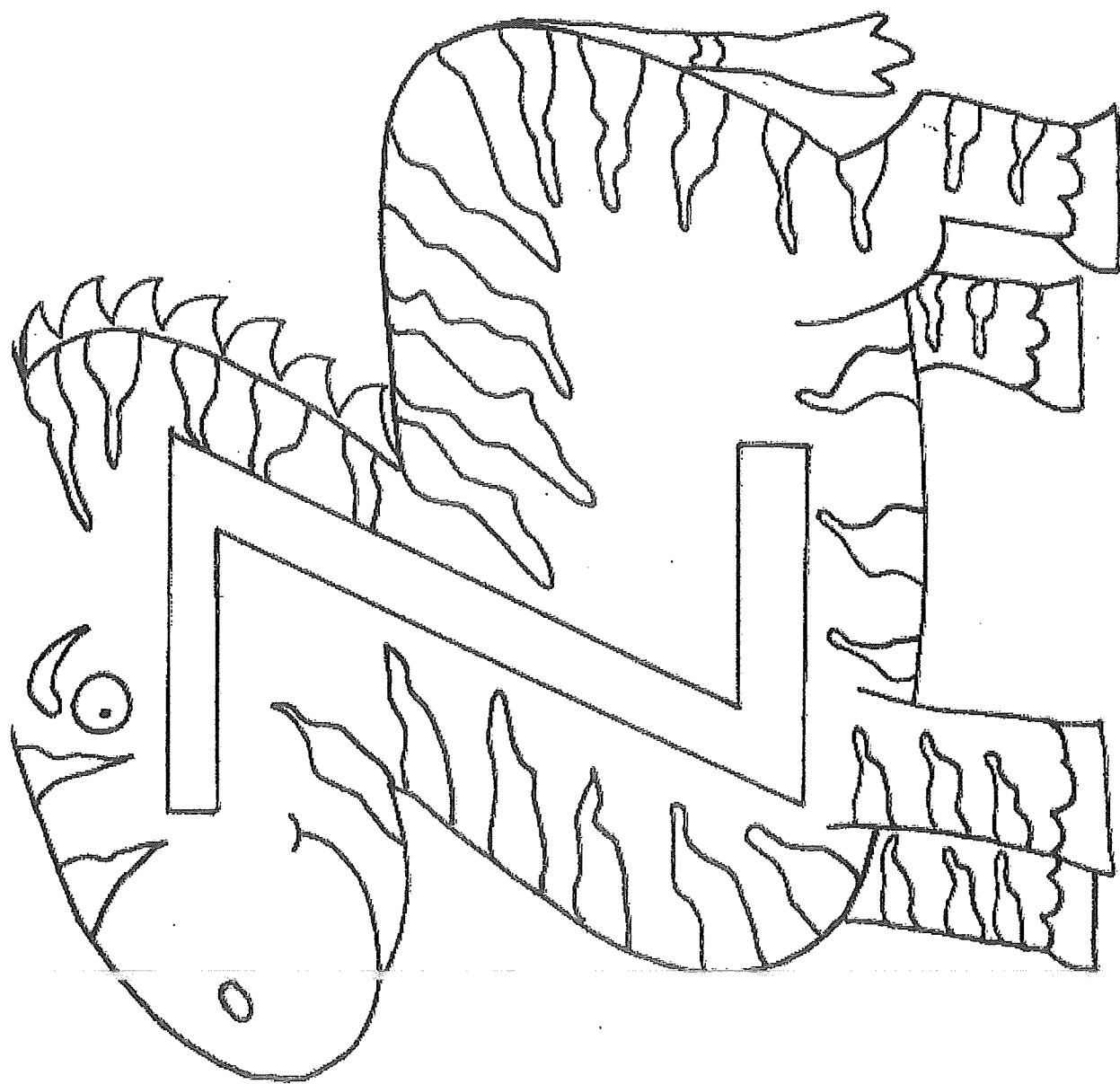

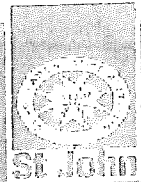
